

CAMPAIGN FOR TOBACCO-FREE KIDS, WASHINGTON, DC

The purpose of this program is to serve as a research/information resource for the tobacco control community and to raise awareness of the benefits of comprehensive tobacco control programs, excise taxes, clean indoor air and cessation services.

DANA-FARBER CANCER INSTITUTE, BOSTON, MA

This program uses TreND (Tobacco Research Network on Disparities) and NCI Community Network Programs to develop and validate a set of "media/message" exposure measures that can be used widely when measuring tobacco-related message exposure, especially among audiences that use "minority" oriented media as well as those who may or may not have access to channels because of poverty or other barriers.

JOHN HOPKINS UNIVERSITY, BLOOMBERG SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH, BALTIMORE, MD

This grant forged a partnership on domestic tobacco research and technical assistance. Services include one cost-effectiveness analysis, technical assistance, a seminar series, and other pilot activities.

TRUSTEES OF DARTMOUTH COLLEGE, HANOVER, NH

This program involves a two and a half year study of smoking in the movies to determine the influence of American youth exposure to billions of tobacco/smoking impressions through popular movies and shows that movie smoking also influences youth smoking initiation abroad.

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA, SAN FRANCISCO (UCSF), SAN FRANCISCO, CA

The Tobacco Documents Library was developed and maintains a robust and user-friendly search and retrieval system and tools to efficiently manage the data, including maintaining the industry documents in a standardized format. The Digital Library also collaborates with national and international groups to improve access by promoting a standardized indexing strategy and through selectively indexing significant material and providing training to communities to effectively access the documents.
